ACAUTION

- 1. Clean only with a dry microfiber towel, or clean with a glass cleaning solution by applying to a towel. DO NOT apply cleaning solution directly on the display.
- 2. If the TV is to be mounted near a fireplace, allow two feet of space or clearance between the TV and fireplace.
- 3. Do not defeat the safety purpose of the polarized or grounding-type plug. A polarized plug has two blades with one wider than the other. A grounding type plug has two blades and a third grounding prong. The wide blade or the third prong are provided for safety. When the provided plug does not fit into the outlet, consult an electrician for replacement of the obsolete outlet. This product must be grounded. Connect only to properly grounded power outlets.
- 4. Protect the power cord from being walked on or pinched, particularly at plugs, convenience receptacles and the point where they exit from the product. Make sure that the plug and power cable are not damaged before plugging them in.
- 5. If a surge protector is not in use, unplug this product during a lightning storm or when the product has not been used for long periods of time.
- 6. Refer all servicing to qualified service personnel. Servicing is required when the product has been damaged in any way, such as if the power-supply cord or plug is damaged, liquid or objects have entered into the product, or when the product does not operate normally, or has been dropped.

- 7. Do not overload wall outlets, extension cords, or integral convenience receptacles as this can result in a risk of fire or electric shock.
- 8. When replacement parts are required, be sure the service technician uses replacement parts specified by the manufacturer or those that have the same characteristics as the original part. Unauthorized substitutions may result in fire, electric shock or other hazards.

- 13. The socket-outlet must be installed near the unit and easily accessible.
- 14. The main plug is used as the disconnect and shall remain readily operable.
- 15. Batteries (battery pack or installed batteries) should not be exposed to excessive heat such as direct sunlight, fire or other heat sources.
- 16. Class I product: This symbol indicates that it requires a safety connection of protective earthing (ground). A warning that a product with CLASS I construction shall be connected to a MAINS socket outlet with a protective earthing connection.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Solution/Issue
	Make sure the power cord is plugged in.
	Try another AC outlet.
TV does not operate	Power is off, check fuse or circuit breaker.
	Unplug unit for an hour, then plug it back in.
	Check the volume settings.
	Sound muted? Press 🖏 button.
Normal picture, but no sound	Try another channel.
sound	Check audio cable connections.
	Check to see if power button is pressed in the 'on' position.
	Make sure the remote control is in range with no obstructions.
The remote control does not work	Check the batteries.
does not work	Correct operating mode set: TV, VCR etc.
	Station or Cable TV experiencing problems, tune to another station.
	Check sound adjustments (Volume or Mute).
Poor sound or no sound	Check for sources of possible interference.
	Check Digital Sound out Settings. Make sure this setting is set to PCM by going to All settings > Sound > Additional Settings > Digital Sound Out > Select PCM.
	Station or Cable TV experiencing problems, tune to another station.
	Make sure channels are set into memory.
Poor picture or no picture	Check antenna or Cable TV connections, adjust antenna.
picture	Check for sources of possible interference.
	Check picture control adjustments.
	Ensure the antenna amplifier is turned on for Antenna TV.
	Adjust the antenna position to a stronger signal receiving angle.
Poor TV reception	Check if the Antenna connection is tight.
	Check if there is power supplied to the Antenna distribution box.
	Check if the incoming cable is connected to the correct cable / antenna wall connection.
	Ensure antenna amp is turned off for cable signal.
	Check if incoming cable is connected correctly.
Poor Cable / Satellite TV	Ensure cable splitter box has power.
Reception	Check if the incoming cable is connected to the correct cable / Satellite wall connection.
	Ensure Dish has no obstruction.

Problem	Solution/Issue
TV shuts off	Sleep Timer is set. Power interrupted.
Black and white image from the connected AV device	Check video connections on both the TV and connected AV device. Ensure all video cables are connected firmly.
