Set-up

TO PREPARE FOR "SURPRISE" ADVERSE CONDITIONS, HOWEVER, MAKE SURE GUY LINES/ ROPES ON THE STRUCTURE ARE SUFFICIENTLY TAUT BETWEEN THE STRUCTURE AND STAKE, ADJUST AS NEEDED.

1. Find a clear and level site for your gazebo. Remove from case and undo ties (**Fig.2**). Stand the shelter up on the center hub.

2. Open the gazebo with the roof facing up, with the poles (Fig.3A) on the inside. Pull out the hub at the center of the side panels (Fig.3B) while holding the roof line with the opposite hand and stepping on the gazebo skirt base to help pull the side panel out (Fig.3C). Repeat this step for each side panel.

3. Enter through the door and push the roof center hub up until erect. Assemble and install the door poles on each side of the door. Insert each end of the pole into the webbing loop (Fig.4).

4. Stake out the Picnic Popup Gazebo and use the guy lines. Attach optional sun shade panels with hook and loop fasteners (Fig.5,6).

AWARNING

AFTER SET-UP CHECK THE CORNERS OF THE ROOF FABRIC AND MAKE SURE ROOF LINE IS PROPERLY POSITIONED ON FRAMING OTHERWISE WATER MAY COLLECT ON THE ROOF LINE. WATER ADDS WEIGHT, WHICH WEAKENS THE OVERALL STRUCTURE. AVOID POSSIBLE COLLAPSE BY CHECKING AND REMOVING ANY WATER ACCUMULATION THAT MAY OCCUR.

Take Down

- **1.** To store the Picnic Popup Gazebo, remove all stakes and guidelines.
- 2. If applicable remove optional sun shade.
- 3. Remove and dissemble door poles.

A CAUTION

BE CAUTIOUS TO NOT USE EXCESSIVE FORCE WHEN REMOVING THE POLE STRUCTURES.

- **4.** Push in on the side panel hub (**Fig.3B**) from the outside to collapse side panel. Repeat this step for all side panels. Push down on the roof until collapsed.
- **5.** Grab one corner of the Picnic Popup Gazebo base and fold over in half. Fold remaining corners over until the Gazebo is the same shape as in step 1.
- **6.** Carefully lift and insert disassembled Gazebo into the carry bag, as well as the stakes, guy lines and poles.

Maintenance

- Picnic Popup Gazebo is NOT machine washable.
 Picnic Popup Gazebo is NOT machine dryable.
- To clean the product, hand wash using mild dish washing soap and soft bristle brush. Allow the fabric to completely air dry.
- Wipe down all parts steel, plastic, and fiberglass before putting away for the next season's use. Salt from ocean air can cause damage.
- DO NOT store Picnic Popup Gazebo while wet. Storing wet can cause mildew.
- Salt, mildew and other causes and subsequent effects are NOT covered under the limited warranty.
