
## **A CAUTION**

## Assembly

**NOTE:** The Euro Recliner comes with the back lying on top of the seat cushion.

1. Lift the seat back and position the single brackets at the lower seat back in between the double brackets on the seat bottom, aligning all three holes (Fig.1).





2. Once the holes are properly aligned, slide the provided bolts (Fig.2A) through all three holes.







## 3. 3. Secure the bolts with the provided nuts (Fig.3A).





- 4. Place the arm pads (Fig.4A) on the chair.
- **5.** Secure the arm pads to the arm tube **(Fig.4B)** with two screws per side **(Fig.4C)**.
- **6.** Secure the arm pads to the back of the chair, using one screw per side (Fig.4D).





7. Insert the plastic, threaded knob (Fig.5A) into the hole on the metal base (one on each side) and tighten.



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
