Resources Required

- Cordless or electric drill or screw gun
- Appropriate drill bits
- Ratchet set
- Tape measure
- #10 galvanized screws

Preparation

1. Before ordering your furniture, strip the existing furniture off of the boat.
2. Inspect the flooring and subfloor to make sure they are in good condition.
3. Measure the deck from bow to stern and measure the beam length, taking into consideration any bracketry or previous mounting locations that may interfere with your installation.

NOTE: When ordering furniture, take into consideration the corner bow radius (Fig. 1A), door placement and direction, and any support brackets.

NOTE: When you receive your furniture, inspect the boxes for any damage that may have occurred in transit.



Installation

1. Install the provided threaded studs (Fig. 2A) into the pre-drilled holes in the bottom of the seatback and hand-tighten.



2. Place the seatback (Fig. 3A) on the molded base (Fig. 3B) so that the threaded studs enter the pre-drilled holes in the molded base. Secure the threaded studs to the base using the provided washers and nuts.



3. Attach the seat base (Fig. 4A) to the molded base (Fig. 4B) by inserting the provided screws through the hinges (Fig. 4C) into the pre-drilled holes.



4. Place the seat in the desired position and secure to the deck using four #10 galvanized screws (Fig. 5).

NOTE: If this seat is being used to replace an old seat, the old fasteners may be re-used.

Maintenance

- To clean seats, wash with mild soap and water and dry thoroughly. Avoid harsh chemicals that can damage the material.
- Cover seats when not in use.
