Purpose

This document outlines the procedure for replacing/installing an 8000 series screen installation.







Moving parts can pinch, crush or cut. Keep clear and use caution.

Procedure

- 1. Slide the window (Fig. 1A) open a minimum of 6" to install the screen.
- **2.** Locate the screen springs attached to the screen frame (Fig. 1B).
- **3.** Align the screen springs into the screen frame channel (Fig. 2A) above the bottom curve of the window frame.
- **4.** Simultaneously push the springs into the screen channel while pushing the opposite side of the screen frame into the channel (Fig. 1C). The screen will make a snap sound when it is inserted.
- **5.** To ensure proper installation, check that both the window and screen slide correctly in the window frame (Fig. 3).
