RV WINDOW RAIN TEST

WINDOWS

Purpose

This document outlines the appropriate way to conduct a water/rain test on Lippert windows.

Safety



Do NOT use a pressure washer or a high-powered nozzle of any kind to do the water test. Using a pressure washer or high-powered nozzle could damage the window and cause water intrusion.

Resources Required


- Two people
- Garden hose with nozzle set to gentle shower or rain

Procedure

- **1.** Make sure window is dry.
- **2.** Have one person stand inside the unit to watch for any water intrusion.
- **3.** Stand 5 to 10 feet away and spray the window from above with a nozzle (Fig. 1) set to gentle shower or rain so the water covers the entire window (Fig. 2).
- **4.** Continue spraying the window for about two minutes.

NOTE: Water between the panes exiting the weep holes (Fig. 2A) is NOT a defect. Weep holes are designed for that purpose.
